


Nation's Report Card


The National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) arts assessment is the only national assessment for the arts. In 2016, about 8,800 eighth-graders attending public and private schools across the nation responded to and critiqued existing works of music and visual arts and created their own original artwork. In addition, students and school administrators responded to survey questionnaires that look at students' participation in and access to the arts.


Student Performance Stayed Steady Overall



8th-grade Music and Art Class Enrollment Unchanged

In 2016, 63 percent of eighth-graders reported taking a music class in school and 42 percent reported taking a visual arts course in school, which were not significantly different from 2008.
